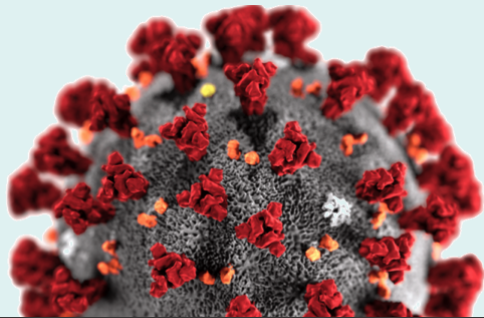


How to Prevent Catching & Spreading **Coronavirus**

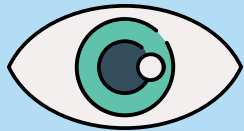
Follow these tips to prevent yourself from catching coronavirus, or from potentially spreading the virus to others. Helpful tips for the conference season.



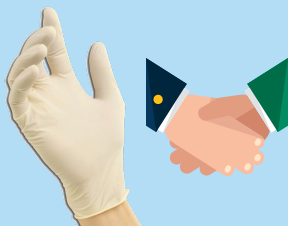
How to Prevent Catching The Virus



Wash your hands often, for at least 20 seconds using antibacterial soap or hand sanitizer.



Avoid touching your eyes and mouth with unwashed hands.



As a home inspector, you should wear gloves while on an inspections and try to avoid close contact with people who are sick.



Cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue and throw out the tissue. Remember that the virus can stay there or on clothing for up to a week.

How to Prevent Spreading the Virus



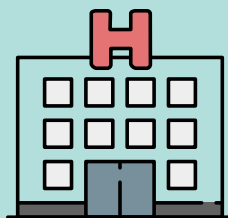
Disinfect surfaces that you touch. Wash your hands often, for at least 20 seconds.



Attending a conference means that you're in close proximity to others. Avoid handshakes and instead fist-bump, bow or touch elbows as a greeting instead.



The recommendation from the CDC is to stay home for at least 14 days if you show symptoms or have been in contact with someone who has symptoms.



Monitor your symptoms and seek medical attention if your symptoms worsen.
